



# Gleason Beach Roadway Realignment Project

State Route 1, Post Mile 15.1/15.7, Sonoma County, California

Winter 2017

Caltrans proposes to realign a section of State Route (SR) 1 near Gleason Beach in Sonoma County (see INSET) to maintain SR 1, which is the only road connecting the communities of Bodega Bay and Jenner. State Route 1 has been damaged by multiple erosive forces and the road continues to be undermined by erosion and is vulnerable to future storms. In late 2016, Caltrans issued an emergency work order to temporarily stabilize the worsening roadway.

## Project Description

The Gleason Beach Realignment Project would construct an approximately 3,700-foot, two-lane roadway and 850-foot long bridge span over Scotty Creek. The two-lane roadway and bridge span would be 49 feet wide including 6- to 8-foot shoulders and a 6-foot sidewalk in the southbound direction to accommodate bicycle and pedestrian access. The existing box culvert and grade-separation structure at Scotty Creek would be removed.

The project also includes three separate access roads to existing Highway 1, as well as public improvements throughout the project and a vehicular turnaround and a dedicated parking pad.

## Project Status

Caltrans certified the Final Environmental Impact Report/Environmental Assessment (EIR/EA) on June 30, 2016. Next, Caltrans is preparing to submit permit applications and obtaining agency approvals by early-2018 to commence construction in 2019, including, but not limited to:

- Water Quality Certification by the Regional Water Quality Control Board under Section 401 of the Clean Water Act.
- Permits approval by the U.S. Army Corps of Engineers under Section 404 of the Clean Water Act
- 1602 Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement from the California Department of Fish and Wildlife
- Coastal Development Permit/Local Coastal Plan Amendment



## Next Informational Meeting/Public Design Selection

**Your Input is Needed!** Caltrans invites you to an upcoming Public Design Selection Meeting to view and provide input on the latest roadway and bridge project renderings.

Caltrans has incorporated public and partnering agency input, and has refined the bridge design to include complementary features to preserve the scenic qualities of the landscape and meet the need to provide reliable, long-term access to the coastal communities.

At the Design Selection meeting, Caltrans will present several, refined structure designs and will discuss the environmental, structural and aesthetic considerations that have shaped the latest designs.

Following a brief presentation, the public will be handed a note card on which to indicate their first and second bridge design preference. The Caltrans Project Development Team will be available to discuss the bridge renderings and project components and will collect your input.

Public input will be one of the criteria that influences Caltrans formal bridge type selection which is scheduled for late February.

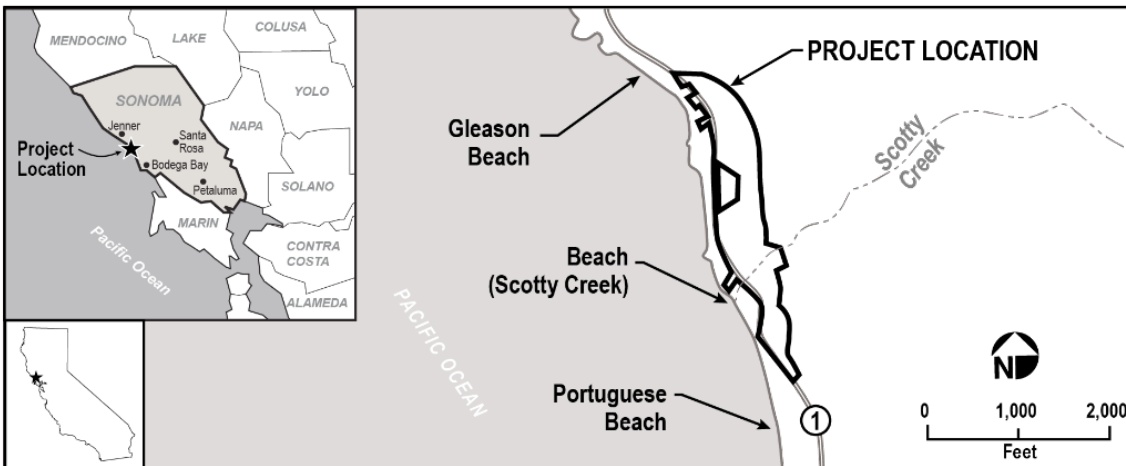
